Attention all Families We are asking for your help!



There are a few things that we ask our students to do each day, and we need your help in encouraging these behaviours.

- EVERYONE is asked to walk their bikes / scooters while on school grounds both in the mornings and afternoons
- the wearing of safety helmets is a legal requirement for all riders
- bikes / scooters must be WALKED across all crossings
- if crossing the road near school please model appropriate use of the marked crossings, including checking for traffic and walking carefully
- bikes need to be walked on busy footpaths, especially when close to crossings and students boarding buses
- ALL students are asked to sit in the Top playground in the morning before school. If you are staying with your child, please ask them to sit next to you. No students are to wait at classrooms. All students move to class lines when the bell rings

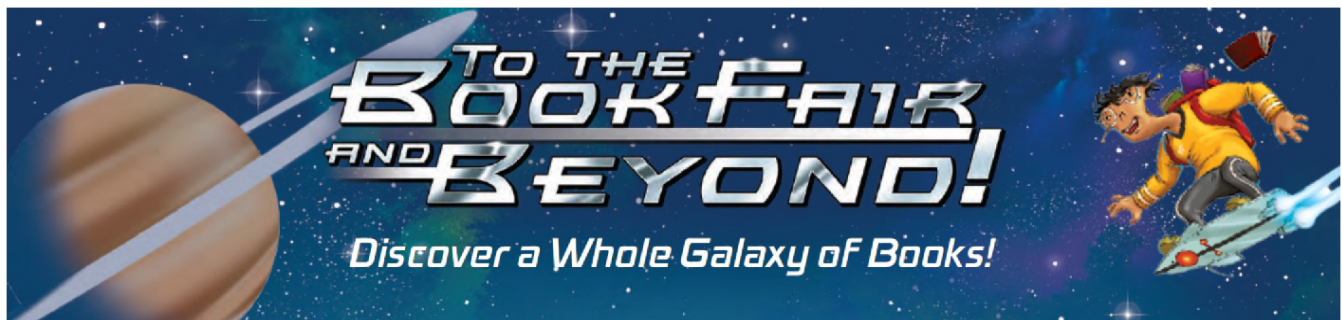

What's on at BPS

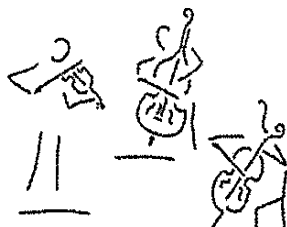
District Swimming
